What is Art and Design?

Art is an exciting and stimulating subject for the independent and creative student who enjoys painting and drawing. The course will explore various aspects of Art and Design and the students will be exposed to a wide range of media and styles.

What careers and University courses can Art and Design lead to?

A good grade in Art and Design at A level is valued by universities and employers, as it requires you to demonstrate the ability to solve creative problems and think independently. This course lays an appropriate foundation for further study of Art in higher education, for example on a Foundation course at an Art College, from which students go on to study subjects such as Fashion, Product Design, Fine Art, Interior Design, Theatre and Film/Set Design and Graphic Design. Students often study Architecture after completing an A Level in Art and Design.
